

Configuring the Sprint Sanyo SCP-7050 for use with VRS Networks and the TSC2

Sanyo SCP-7050

- 1. With the phone turned on press Menu/OK button.
- 2. Highlight the Settings icon.
- 3. Press the Menu/OK button.
- 4. Scroll down and highlight Bluetooth.
- 5. Press the Menu/OK button.
- 6. Highlight Enable/Disable.
- 7. Press the Menu/OK button.
- 8. Highlight Enable.
- 9. Press the Menu/OK button.
- 10. Bluetooth is now turned on.

TSC2

- 1. Turn on the TSC2 by pressing and releasing the power button at the bottom left of the keyboard.
- 2. Tap on Start at the top left of the screen.
- 3. Tap on Settings.
- 4. Tap on the Connections tab located at the bottom of the screen.
- 5. Tap on the Bluetooth icon.
- 6. Tap on the check box to Turn on Bluetooth.
- 7. Tap on the Devices tab at the bottom of the screen.

Sanyo SCP-7050

- 1. Highlight Visbility.
- 2. Press the Menu/OK button.
- 3. Highlight Visible for 3 min.
- 4. Press the Menu/OK button.
- 5. Press the Back button.



- 1. Tap on New Partnership.
- 2. You will see the TSC2 searching for Bluetooth devices.
- 3. You should see Sanyo SCP-7050
- 4. Tap on Sanyo SCP-7050 to highlight it.
- 5. Tap on Next.
- 6. You are prompted to enter a Passkey.
- 7. Enter 0000 for the Passkey.
- 8. Tap Next.

Sanyo SCP-7050

- 1. You will be prompted to Bond with TSC2 with its Serial Number.
- 2. Press the top left key for Accept.
- 3. Enter 0000 for the Passkey on the Sanyo SCP-7050.
- 4. Press the top left key for OK.

TSC2

- 1. Verify the Check Box for Dial-Up Networking is checked.
- 2. Tap Finish.
- 3. Tap on OK at the top right of the screen.

Sanyo SCP-7050

- 1. Press the Back button.
- 2. Press the Back button.
- 3. Press the Back button.
- 4. Highlight the tools icon.
- 5. Press the Menu/OK button
- 6. Highlight Bluetooth.
- 7. Press the Menu/OK button
- 8. Highlight your device.
- 9. Press the top right button for Options.
- 10. Highlight Auto-Accept.
- 11. Press the Menu/OK button
- 12. Highlight On.
- 13. Press the Menu/OK button.
- 14. Press the Back button.
- 15. Press the Back button.
- 16. Press the Back button.



Creating a Network/Dial-up Connection on the TSC2

- 1. Tap on the Connections icon.
- 2. Tap on Add a new modem connection under My ISP.
- 3. Enter Razor for the Name of the Connection.
- 4. Tap on the drop down list for Select a Modem.
- 5. Select Bluetooth from the drop down list.
- 6. Tap on Next.
- 7. Tap on Sanyo SCP-7050 to highlight.
- 8. Tap on Next.
- 9. Enter #777 for the phone number.
- 10. Tap on Next.
- 11. User Name Leave Blank.
- 12. Password Leave Blank.
- 13. Domain Leave blank.
- 14. Tap on Finish.
- 15. Tap OK at the top right of the screen.
- 16. Tap on X at the top right of the screen to return to the desktop of the TSC2.

Testing Your Internet Connection between the Phone and the TSC2

- 1. Tap on Start.
- 2. Tap on Settings.
- 3. Tap on Connections.
- 4. Tap on Manage existing connections under My ISP.
- 5. Tap and hold on your connection.
- 6. Tap on Connect.
- 7. The Network Log On screen appears.
- 8. Tap the check box to select Save Password.
- 9. Tap OK.
- 10. The "connecting" window will appear and dial the number.
- 11. When the window disappears, you are connected to the internet.
- 12. To disconnect tap on the icon to the left of the speaker icon at the top of the screen.
- 13. Tap on disconnect.

If your connection is not successful, check with Sprint to make sure your plan is correct.
